23.10.08	Councillor Area Reports
	Gordon Kemp reported that problems with the air source heat pump at the school which may be in contravention to the planning permission granted. Gordon advised he was continuing to pursue this matter as a

resident with the planning department. He also reported that the repair to the footpath on the junction of Barby Road and Greenway was a trip hazard (the clerk agreed to report) Caroline Gibbons reported that she had been contacted by a boater from Lancashire re a problem (no details given) at the canal, it also transpires she has also called the clerk and other councillor's but due to not having a phone it is impossible for us to contact back. Alan Mawer reported that there were issues over a manhole cover in the grass outside the bungalows in Archer Avenue (clerk agreed to report to FHG), damaged road in Archer Avenue (clerk agreed to report) and Nettles on footpath between Cross Lane and Nibbits Lane (it was reported that this would be done shortly) Sue Harrison gueried when the Dark Lane strimming would be done, the clerk agreed to chase. John Pomfret reported that a resident had raised concerns over dead tree in School Close, the clerk confirmed it had been reported once before but will report again. The clerk was asked to enquire with West Haddon PC regarding the 20mph speed zone that they had had installed. Adrian Humphries reported that concerns had been raised re Willoughby flooding and the "lake" alongside the canal. Pete Morgan enquired re the crown lifting and suckers around trees on the highways. It was agreed to get done in November, the clerk would try and get a flat bed to assist with moving the trimmings. 23.10.09 Active Travel Proposal After discussions and a few minor tweaks, it was agreed that the Parish Council would proceed with BCAN's proposals. Alan Mawer agreed to make the changes and then forward to the clerk for onward transmission to the proposed recipients. 23.10.10 CRT Dog Bins The Parish Council agreed to get quotes for emptying and take on this cost providing CRT agreed to continue to accept liability and maintenance. 23.10.11 Emergency Plan The sub committee have met and are progressing the plan, it is hoped to include within the plan flow charts of actions. The next course of action is to finalise and then circulate to the Parish Council. Once the draft plan is agreed permission to include people's details will be sought. 23.10.12 School Link Up Feedback Pete Morgan reported back that the school wished to continue the links between the School and Parish Councils. As per the schools wishes it was agreed that Pete Morgan would remain as the PC's link. The school has agreed to go ahead with the Skateboard mural plan and is also planning a remembrance service. 23.10.13 **Braunston CAN** Alan Mawer reported the following: -The sub-station for the chargers at the Boathouse has now been installed. Alan & Helen Morgan have cleared the wildlife area at the church. Southview are aiming to plant natural hedging plants. 23.10.14 Jetty Fields Alan Mawer reported the following: -Ongoing issues with changing the bank account are still occurring. There are two trees (one ash, one poplar) that will need potential work or felling.
