Dear Parishioners.

Easter is a joyful time for the Church as we celebrate our redemption through the death and resurrection of Our Saviour, Jesus Christ. The church was decorated beautifully for the occasion with floral displays, which were arranged by the group of willing helpers who always make All Saints' so attractive. Even though we have no Vicar living in Braunston this Easter, our services were well attended, both by villagers and visitors from the canal.

As we announced last month, a new Team Vicar, the Revd. Claire Rose-Casemore, has been appointed to Braunston. Youth Club


