Village Notes - From our Archives Issue No 34 - January 1973

"Some years ago readers of the 'Sunday Times' were asked to say what they considered the most beautiful sight in the English countryside. One suggested 'an elm against a winter sky in Northamptonshire'. This is of interest to us in Braunston as we have so many of these trees, many planted about 100 years ago - a beautiful legacy. The fine lacelike branches give an air of delicacy but are strong enough to make a nesting place for a variety of birds like rooks, crows and magpies. We hope Dutch elm disease killing trees elswhere in England dies out before reaching our neighbourhood"
