VILLAGE NOTES.

The antics of some animals and birds are quite fascinating, and their aerobatics appear to leave those of their human counterparts at a disadvantage.

The birds we know as Wagtails provide endless entertainment. In Britain we have a few varieties of this breed - some of which migrate as summer visitors, others travel to the South of England in winter. The Pied Wagtail is well established in our neighbourhood, and recently a yellow Wagtail appeared by the canal.

When travelling some distance the undulating flight of these birds is quite distinctive. When collecting insects as food they swoop over the canal. While swallows, martins and swifts, make a fairly long dash, the wagtail twists and manoeuvres as if collecting his victims over a smaller area, but being much more thorough about it. He will then alight, and as if pleased with his efforts, stands flicking his tail and thus earning his name.
