<b>21.03.03</b>	<b>District and County Councillors Reports</b> No reports received
<b>21.03.04</b>	<b>Minutes of Last Meeting (1<sup>st</sup> February 2021)</b> It was proposed by Pete Morgan, seconded by David Cary and carried that the minutes for the meeting be signed as a true record.

<b>21.03.07</b>	<b>DMMO</b> After discussions it was agreed to pursue the access rights to Countryside and that the rest were okay to leave (post meeting note, the entrance to Countryside is a highway so need to intervene)
<b>21.03.08</b>	<b>Request for sign on The Green</b> It was agreed to ask DDC if they can provide and also to try and update Google Maps
<b>21.03.09</b>	<b>Archer Avenue</b> It was agreed that the the additional suggestions should be added and the questionnaire then sent to all households. The responses would be collated and forwarded to highways

<b>21.03.10</b>	<b>Rights of Way</b>
	Alan Mawer reported that he had been in touch with Braunston Walkers and Arnold Brewer and they had agreed to send in any issues they find to the clerk
<b>21.03.11</b>	<b>Dog Litter Bin requested</b>
	It was agreed that if DDC agreed to bins being relocated, the Council would try to move a couple of bins; potential bins are by the Church, in Jettyfields and at the Marina Car Park where there are potential duplications.
<b>21.03.12</b>	<b>Neighbourhood Plan Review</b>
	It was proposed by Alan Mawer, seconded by John Pomfret and carried that the Parish Council accept the recommendations of the NH Plan review and submit to DDC
<b>21.03.13</b>	<b>Annual Parish Meeting</b>
	It was agreed to hold on Monday 24 <sup>th</sup> May at 7.30pm. It is hoped to be able to do in person or at least by a mix of online and in person
<b>21.03.14</b>	<b>Community Assets</b>
	Jo Glover and Pete Morgan reported back on the rules and what assets could be registered, it was agreed that a list would be produced for review and potential submittal to WNC
<b>21.03.15</b>	<b>Potholes in Village</b>
	It was agreed that we would publish how and where to report in the BVN and that a response would be sent to Robert Tuck
<b>21.03.16</b>	<b>Welton Road Play Area</b>
	It was proposed by Sue Harrison, seconded by Pete Morgan and carried that £2350 be spent on replacing the left hand fence in the play area as recommended by the Play Area Inspection  An emergency repair of the swing seat was also needed, so therefore it was proposed by Jo Glover, seconded by Chris Johnson and carried that £150 plus VAT be spent
<b>21.03.17</b>	<b>Planning</b>
	DA/2020/1183 Farnborough Drive to Canal Access – the Parish Council agreed to support (For 5 Against 2 Abstain 3)  The following wording was agreed to accompany the response.  The Parish Council support this application but would also like to see plans for implementation of the next phase of cycleway which will fall within the Braunston Parish as quickly as possible, they would also like to be consulted on and included in any feasibility study for that phase. There are concerns that the next phase could lead to an increased risk of injury to members of the public and therefore a feasibility study of how to ensure that all users are safe is needed as soon as possible.
