21.08.01	<i>Open forum for Members of the Public</i> <p>There were 4 members of public attending (Peter Biggs, Alan Kirk, Paul Chamberlain and Pat Milner)</p> <p>Each was asked what issues they wished to bring to the PCs attention and the items highlighted are summarised below: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• State of the Village generally• Health & Safety Issue at top of Dark Lane• Mowing and Strimming around the village inc. the Pocket Park• Mowing and strimming in the cemetery <p>Alan Mawer responded with the Agreed Braunston CAN strategy and outlined the plans for the various areas of the village.</p> <p>The clerk also confirmed that the contractor by his own admission has been struggling with the extra growth due to weather conditions this year and the reduced number of cuts under the new strategy.</p> <p>In the BVN the church had confirmed that the graveyard is their responsibility and have asked for volunteers to help out</p> <p>The following courses of action were agreed: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Setting Up of Guidelines to the strategy and publishing them – the guidelines to include What it may look like, review deadlines for each area (these may be different for each part of the village)• The clerk to liaise with the contractor to ensure cuts that are due are done• Potential Workdays to be set up for the graveyard• Any ideas for helping to improve the situation to be sent to John Pomfret, he would then collate and report back.
