20.07.05	School Grant After discussion it was proposed by Richard Davey, seconded by Pete Morgan and carried that £336.90 be given to cover the cost of tidying up the entrance area. It was agreed that the clerk should obtain receipts and to advise the school that if they wish to benefit in future they should put together a business plan for submittal in time for the Precept Meeting
20.07.06	Welton Road Play Area It was proposed by Sue Harrison, seconded by Sandra Stapley and carried that £985 be spent on fence repairs
20.07.07	Health and Wellness Meeting Jo Glover reported back that the meeting was attended by Danny Moody of

	NCALC and 14 other councillors. The main topic of the meeting was around Social Prescribing and the projects that were already under way in Moulton and Wootton and working well. It was agreed that the idea is a good one and that the Parish Council should support a separate group involving the whole village. Jo agreed to look at and take on a role to try and co-ordinate
