20.11.13	Precept
	<p>It was agreed that overall the precept should not be increased for the next financial year to try and ease the burden on parishioners for 2021/22 following the COVID19 epidemic</p> <p>The draft budget was gone through and with the addition of a provision for a speed camera (£2,000 spread over two years, proposed by Pete Morgan, seconded by Sue Harrison and carried 10 to 2 in favour) was proposed by Pete Morgan, seconded by John Pomfret and carried that the budget be accepted</p> <p>The budget also included the salary reviews for November 2020 which were approved by the finance sub committee</p> <p>It was therefore agreed that the Precept for the year to 31 March 2022 should be £55244.</p> <p>The details of the budget are shown in Appendix One.</p>
