| 18.11.22 | <i>Precept for year ending March 2020</i> |
| | <p>It was agreed that the reserves at the 31st March 2019 were projected at £60924 although £50482 is already pledged to various projects as listed on the final budget papers. Therefore this leaves a net reserve of £10442</p> <p>It was agreed that overall the precept increase would be limited to 3% of overall band D council tax which equates to approximately £1609. The budget was gone through on an item by item basis with all parties agreeing on whether an increase was needed or not.</p> <p>It was proposed by Graham Newman, seconded by Sandra Stapley and carried that the precept for the year to 31 March 2020 should be £55244.</p> <p>The details of the budget are shown in Appendix One.</p> |
