Scheme Made by The Secretary of State for Education and Science under Section 18 of the Charities Act 1960.

The Foundation

1. In this scheme the expression 'the Foundation' means the Foundation called the Memorial Hall, in the Parish of Braunston, in the Country of Northampton comprised in a Deed dated 15th June 1920 and of which the Braunston Parish Council was appointed to be the Trustee by Deed dated 23rd July 1936.

Administration of Foundation

2. The Foundation and its endowment (including the particulars specified in the Schedule hereto) shall be administered in conformity with the provisions of this Scheme by the Committee of Management hereinafter constituted as the charity trustees thereof:

Provided that until the first Annual General Meeting to be held after the date of this Scheme the Foundation shall be administered by the Braunston Parish Council in accordance with the provisions of this Scheme.

Custodian Trustee

3. The Braunston Parish Council shall be the custodian trustee of the Foundation and the provisions of Section 4(2) of the Public Trustee Act 1906, shall apply to the said Council and to the Committee of management hereinafter constituted, respectively, in like manner as they apply to the Public Trustee and managing trustees.

Committee of Management

4. (1). The Committee of Management (hereinafter called 'the Committee') shall, when complete, and except as in this Scheme provided, consist of twenty members, that is to say:-

SIX Elected Members, to be appointed at the Annual General Meeting to be held as hereinafter provided.

TEN Representative Members, to be appointed:-

One by the Braunston Parochial Church Council,

One by the Committee of the Braunston Women's Institute

One by the Committee of the Braunston branch of the Mother's Union

One by the Braunston Parish Council

One by the Committee of the Braunston Cricket Club

One by the Committee of the Braunston Methodist Church
