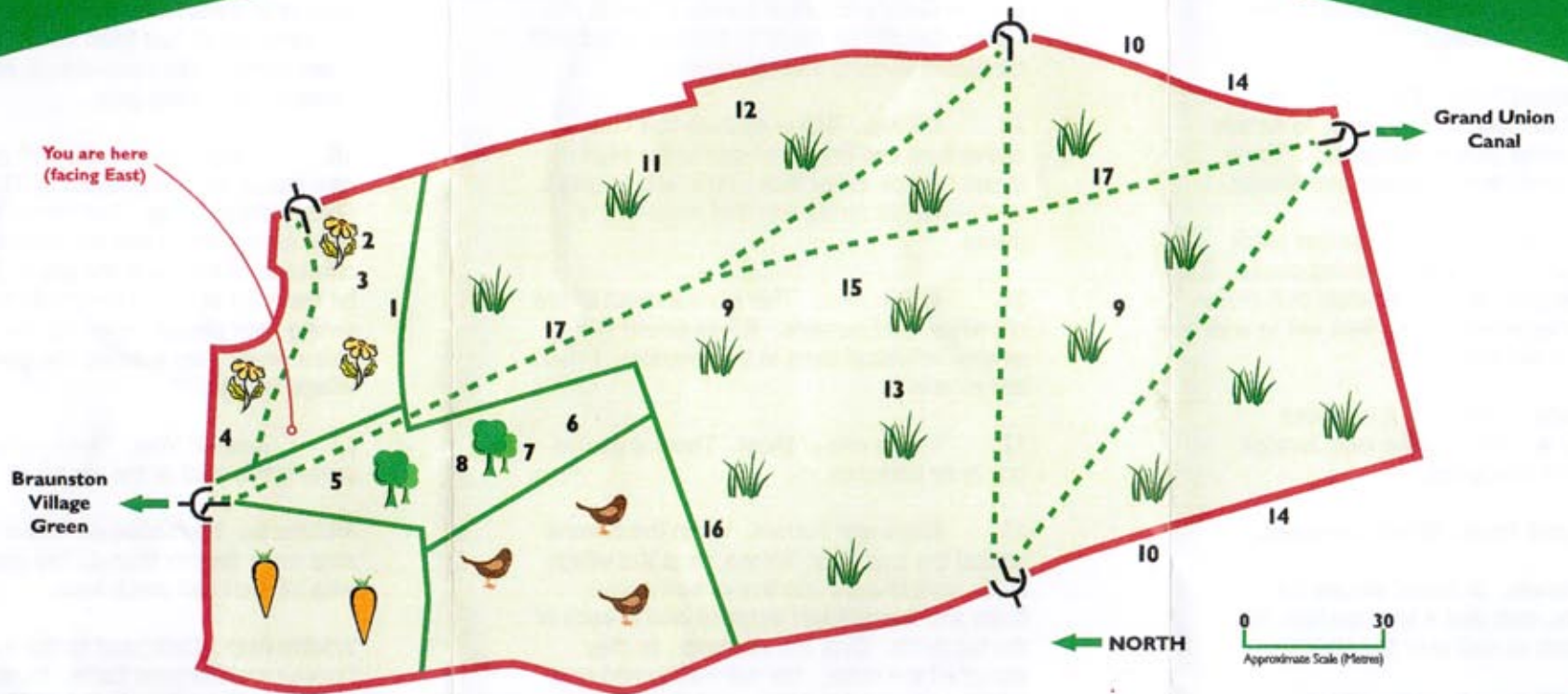


# BRAUNSTON JETTY FIELD

### MAP KEY



**MAIN FIELD** - Ridge and furrow show the medieval farming strips with enclosure hedges cutting across them. A line of lime trees stretches towards the canal.



**SPINNEY** - Native trees are being planted as older ornamental trees die out. There are varied bird habitats. Woodpeckers are encouraged; wild plants established.



**GARDEN** - There are many distinct areas: paths, a stream, a bog section, a log pile, flower beds, bird and bat boxes. A child friendly area - please control dogs.



**ALLOTMENTS** - Nature tamed, innumerable types of delicious crops. There is rich soil at the boundary of the gravel ridge of the village and the clay pastureland.



**GALLIEWILDLIFE** - Reserved exclusively for birds, bugs, bees, butterflies and bats. Please no dogs or cats and definitely no humans. Growth thinned sequentially.
